## Feature Story of the Month

### *Tips for a Successful Animal Communication Consultation*

**1. Understand what the job of an animal communicator actually is.** What I do as an animal communicator is telepathically communicate with your animal companions. I can relay to you their viewpoints, thoughts, feelings, beliefs, expectations, and desires. Then, we can all work together to help you and your animal companions understand each other more, resolve misunderstandings, or have a better connection. Please remember that as an animal communicator I cannot predict the future, magically change behavior, diagnose an illness, or prescribe medical treatment.

**2. When a consultation begins, don't tell me everything about the animal before we start.** All I need to start is the animals' names, ages, physical descriptions, and if the animals are deceased. If this is the first time we have talked to the animals, let their personalities come through clearly to me. That will be your validation that we are talking to the right animals.

However, after we are well into the consultation, please don't hesitate to provide any necessary information to help resolve a conflict or answer a question.

**3. Provide me with positive and negative feedback.** Throughout the consultations, let me know if I am on track or not. Telepathic communication is not a precise form of communication. I have to put the animals' feelings, thoughts, and pictures into words that explain what they are showing me as accurately as possible. Sometimes that is easy to do and sometimes the translation can be more difficult. Let me know if you have questions or doubts. If something doesn't feel right, say so. Just as important, let me know when things sound right. Knowing that I am on the right track helps me move forward with the consultation more quickly.

**4. If you want to know something, ask the question and be specific.** If you have something important to discuss with the animals or an important question to ask them, ask it yourself. Don't wait to see if the animals bring up the subject on their own. Very often what is most important to you is not what is most important to the animals. You might be waiting for the dogs to tell you why they chewed up your couch while they are busy telling me all about the new dog living down the road or chasing squirrels in the backyard.

Also, be very specific with your questions. If you ask something vague like, "How do they feel about what happened yesterday?" You could get dozens of different answers about dozens of different things that are not what you want to know about. If you want to know why the cats were fighting yesterday, ask the question directly. Then you will get a direct answer to your question.

**5. Make sure that you truly want to know the answer to the question before you ask it.** Before you ask your animal companions an important question, make sure that you want to know the truth and are prepared to deal with any consequences that might result from the answer. The animals might not give you the answer that you want to hear. Think about what you would do then. If you are not prepared to honor the answer and the consequences, you are better off not asking the question at all. This does not mean that you have to do everything that the animals say, but you should acknowledge how they answered the question, talk about it, and then come up with a solution that is beneficial to everyone.

**6. Be willing to look at your part of a situation.** Very often when there is a behavior problem, the solution will involve both the animals and the humans. Be prepared to recognize and do your part to help resolve the problem. Often behavior changes in your animal companions can be caused by stress at home, training issues, or other things that you are unaware of. We might find the source of a problem during a consultation and identify possible solutions, but often the real changes in behavior come when the person is willing to make changes, small or big, after the consultation ends.

**7. Take your time and listen to the answers.** This is the most important tip! During the consultation, really listen to what your animal companions are saying. It is easy to get nervous or excited about the communication experience and move too quickly from one question to another. Relax, take your time, and focus on what the animals are saying back to you.

When there is true respect for the animals as spiritual beings, an openness to hear what ever they have to say, and a willingness to understand their point of view---that is when miracles can happen, behaviors can shift, and a deeper connection is found with your animal family.

## New Fees & Policies - Effective January 1, 2008

### **Animal Communication**

Phone consultations are \$50 for 30 minutes plus \$1 per minute for each additional minute. For example, a 40 minute consultation is \$60 (\$50 for the thirty minutes + \$10 for the additional 10 minutes).

In your home or stable consultations are \$80 for 1 hour plus a mileage fee of 50 cents per mile (round trip) from Karin's house in Kokomo, Indiana and a trip fee based on the amount of travel time.

Group consultations at your location - Multiple short in-person animal communication sessions are available for a group of friends, clubs, organizations, or events.

Group consultation fees are charged per person at the rate of \$30 for 15 minutes (for a minimum of 8 participants - total consultation time of 2 hours) or \$40 for 20 minutes (for a minimum of 6 participants - total consultation time of 2 hours). The fees or minimum number of participants required can vary depending on the amount of travel time. Call or email me for exact fees and more information.

### **Healing Arts**

Distance healing sessions for animals & people are \$50 for a 30 minute distance healing and energy balancing session plus \$1 per minute for the follow up phone call. For example, a 30 minute healing session plus a 15 minute phone consultation would be \$65 (\$50 for the healing work + \$15 for the phone call.) For multiple animals and people on the same day, the fee is \$50 for each healing session, followed by a phone call for an additional \$1 per minute.

\*During the phone consultation, you can discuss the healing session and/or have a short communication session with your animals. You can schedule more than 30 minutes for the phone call, but you need to let me know in advance that you need extra time.

In-person healing sessions for people at Karin's are \$60 for 1 hour or \$85 for 1.5 hours.

\*The time includes the total time at Karin's house---the discussion prior to healing work, the healing session, and follow up consultation about the healing session. The 1 hour session will usually include 30-40 minutes of healing work and 1.5 hour session will usually include 1 hour of healing work.

In-person healing sessions for animals at Karin's are \$60 for 1 hour for one animal. For multiple animals on the same day, the fee is \$60 per hour using the guidelines below for the amount of time to schedule. You can also combine sessions for people and animals on the same day.

1.5 hours for up to 2 animals, fee is \$90  
2 hours for up to 2-3 animals, fee is \$120  
2.5 hours for up to 3-4 animals, fee is \$150  
3 hours for up to 4-5 animals, fee is \$180

\*During the hour, we can discuss issues related to the healing work with the animal, but for other animal communication issues, additional time must be scheduled after the healing session at the same fee rate as an animal communication phone consultation.

In your home or stable healing sessions for animals are \$60 for 1 hour plus a mileage fee of 50 cents per mile (round trip) from Karin's house in Kokomo, Indiana and a trip fee based on the amount of travel time. For multiple animals on the same day, the fee is \$60 per hour using the guidelines listed above for the amount of time to schedule.
